



Guide to setting up your Scotnet dial up account with Mac OS 9

Introduction

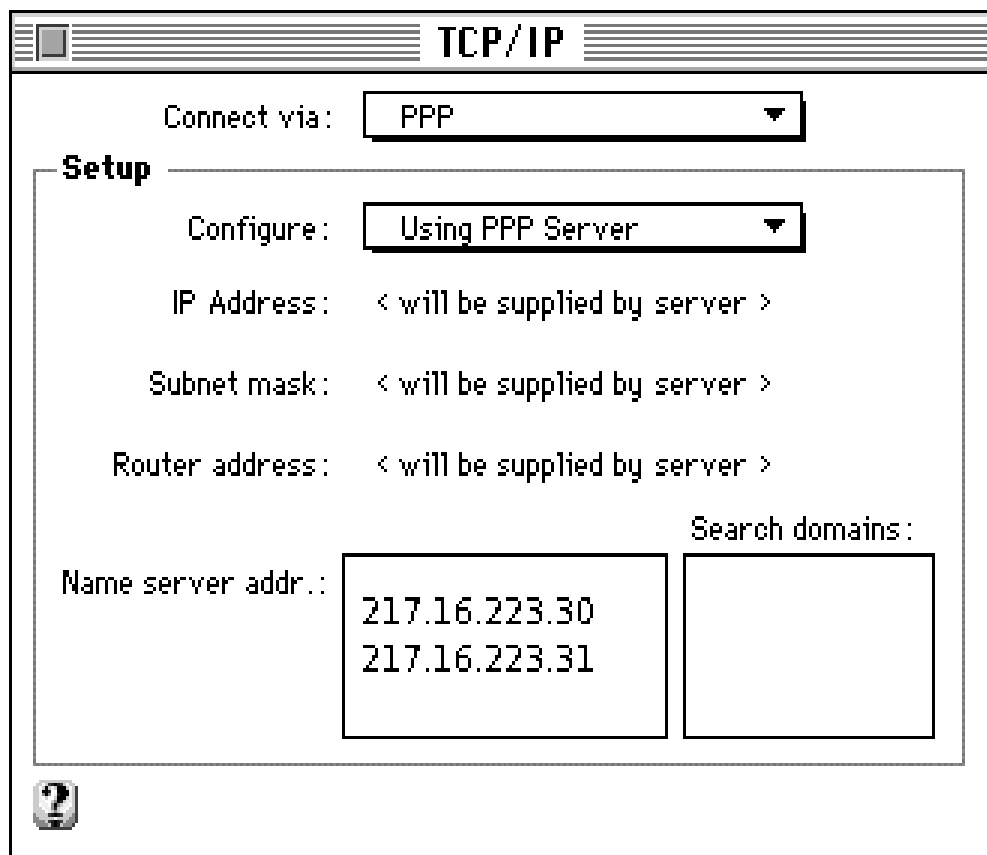
The purpose of this document is to illustrate the process required to configure your mackintosh computer running OS 9 for dial up access with Scotnet.

Step 1: Configuring TCP/IP

Click the apple  icon, **control panels**, and click on **TCP/IP**

Ensure that "Connect via" is set as **PPP**, Configure is set to "**Using PPP Server**" and enter the following IP addresses in the "**Name server addr**" field:

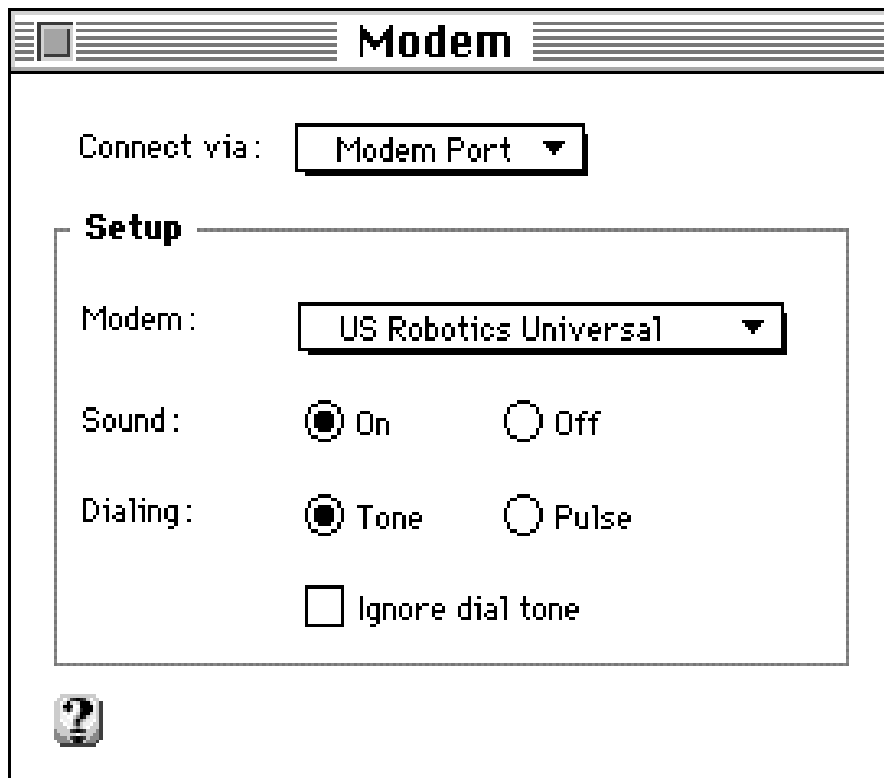

Step 2: Configuring your modem

Click the apple  icon, **control panels**, and click on “**Modem**”

Ensure that “**Connect via**” is set to **modem port** and **for modem, ensure your modem is selected**. **If your modem is not listed, you must ensure that the correct modem script is present on your system (Normally from an installation CD) under your hard disk, system folder, extensions folder, modem scripts. If it is not present, please copy the appropriate script to said directory.**



Ensure that **dialing** is set to **Tone**


Step 3: Configuring remote access

Click the apple  icon, **control panels**, and click on “**Remote Access**”

Ensure that “Registered User” is selected.

In user name, enter your Scotnet user name and password respectively

Under number, enter 0845 608 1387
